Sparkling, Cap Classique & Champagne

375ml | 750ml

Graham Beck Brut – Robertson

280 | 480

The Stalwart of SA bubbles, for good reason. Light yeasty aromas, limey fresh fruit on the nose and rich creamy complexity on the palate. The exceptionally fine mousse contributes the freshness and finesse.

Krone Night Nectar Demi-Sec – Tulbagh

440

Pinot Noir & Chardonnay deliver flowers in bloom and honeycomb aromas. The scent of summer. Honeyed quince, melon, tarte tatin. On entry baking apples, cinnamon, dessert peaches, and glacé pineapple.

Durbanville Hills Sparkling Rosé – Durbanville

260

A full and generous palate, preceded by aromas of Turkish Delight, rose water and citrus. The fine bouquet of bubbles is enhanced by touches of grapefruit and spun sugar.

JC Le Roux Le Domain – Coastal

230

All the finesse and crispness of Sauvignon Blanc, intertwined with the gentle sweetness of the Muscadell. Refreshing and youthful, this fun sparkling wine offers an abundance of fresh fruit and a lingering, clean finish.

Graham Beck Bliss Nectar – Robertson

470

All the hallmarks of an outstandingly crafted, timeless bottle fermented sparkling wine. The Bliss Nectar is an indulgent delight for the senses with its enchanting hints of butterscotch, honey and praline.

Pongrácz Brut – Stellenbosch

440

An explosion of pinpoint bubbles, characteristic yeastiness on the nose followed by the rich complexity and lingering aftertaste.

Moët & Chandon Imperial NV – Épernay, France

1600

Moët Imperial is this House's iconic champagne, made with Pinot Noir, Pinot Meunier and Chardonnay. Created since 1887, it embodies Moët & Chandon's unique style, a style distinguished by its bright fruitiness, its seductive palate and its elegant maturity.

Veuve Clicquot Brut Yellow Label – Champagne, France

1500

The nose shows hints of white fruits, followed by vanilla and brioche. On the palate, the initial sip delivers a combination of freshness and forcefulness which is synonymous with Yellow Label.



White Wines

Sauvignon Blanc

Depending on the climate and terroir, flavours vary from tropical fruit to more herbaceous, green grassy and asparagus-dominated flavours.

Van Loveren – Robertson

69 | 188

It has a typical grassy character. It is an aromatic and full-bodied wine with hints of melon and figs on the palate.

La Motte La Famille – Franschhoek

96 | 258

Lots of gooseberry on the nose, together with lemon and tropical notes. Very polished and silky on the palate. The finish is juicy, light and lingering.

Groote Post – Darling

289

Aromas of grapefruit and guava on the nose followed by mouth-watering acidity and upfront citrus fruit on the palate.

Spier Signature – Western Cape

205

Intense aromas of gooseberries, passion fruit and green fig, with green bell pepper undertones. The palate is fresh and mouth-watering with a well-balanced acidity.

Durbanville Hills – Durbanville

210

It is a full-bodied wine that dazzles with its grassy tropical fruit and subtle gooseberry on the palate.

Hermanuspietersfontein Kaalvoet Meisie – Hemel & Aarde

315

Dominant aromas of juicy peaches and ripe pineapple, elegantly complemented by exotic Pacific fruits. On the palate, a harmonious balance of refreshing minerality, appealing texture, and persistent length.

Springfield Life from Stone – Robertson

340

Notes of red pepper and passion fruit, well-balanced minerality.



Chenin Blanc

Believed to be one of the earliest cultivars to be planted in South Africa, likely introduced by Jan Van Riebeeck in 1655. Today, the most widely planted grape varietal in South Africa, with our Chenin Blanc wines ranking amongst the finest in the world. Typical flavours include greengages, pears, honey and tropical tones like banana and pineapple.

Nederburg Stein (Semi-Sweet) – Western Cape **62 | 162**

This ever-popular semi-sweet abounds with aromas of pineapple, apricots and guava, followed by a soft and fragrant fruitiness.

Spier Signature – Western Cape **72 | 185**

Crisp and fruity, bursting with aromas of green guava, pear, ripe peach notes and hints of litchi on the nose, with a well-balanced palate, typical of the sun-kissed slopes of the Cape Winelands.

Cederberg – Cederberg **270**

This cool-climate Chenin Blanc leads with a fragrant nose of winter melon, stone fruit and broad tropical aromas. This delicious style is refreshing with all the abundance of fruit shared on the palate, ending with a crisp, clean, lingering golden delicious apple finish.

Stellenrust Barrel Fermented – Stellenbosch **460**

It has dramatic aromatics of yellow peach, apricot and pineapple plus marzipan and waxy undertones. The palate is full-bodied and well-rounded with tangy acidity and savoury finish.



Chardonnay

Originating from the Burgundy region in France, currently the most produced white grape varietal worldwide. Well-suited to fermentation and wood ageing. Depending on climatic conditions, soil type and use of wood, expect flavours of citrus, vanilla, tropical fruit and smokiness.

Durbanville Hills – Durbanville

82 | 210

Soft and easy drinking. Buttery notes of citrus and on the palate, an abundance of yellow peaches, pineapple and grapefruit that ends with a sweet sensation.

Paul Cluver Village – Elgin

310

This wine is a beautifully poised expression of Chardonnay with notes of citrus and citrus blossom followed by aromas of white peach and a maritime salinity. The energetic, fresh palate is long and lingering with a delicate, fine finish.

Spier Seaward – Coastal

315

Aromas of mandarin, lime zest, peach and citrus blossom with undertones of raw almonds. The zesty palate offers fresh citrus, nectarine, and well-integrated vanilla with a mineral texture.

Meerlust – Stellenbosch

550

Complex, appealing nose of apricot, peach, pear, lemon zest and floral notes with hints of toasted almonds. On the palate the wine is well-structured and linear but retains generous focused stone fruit flavours with a sleek, balanced, and crisp acidity.

Rupert and Rothschild Baroness Nadine – Coastal

620

Aromas of mandarin orange, delicate orange blossom, and subtle vanilla entices the senses. On the palate, discover crisp minerality, complemented by the sweetness of passion fruit and nuanced oak. This elegant Chardonnay leaves a fresh, lingering impression—a testament to its craftsmanship and legacy.



White Blends

750ml

Van Loveren Daydream Chardonnay Pinot Noir – Robertson **190**

Shows upfront lime on the nose with subtle undertones of strawberry.

Haute Cabrière Chardonnay / Pinot Noir – Franschhoek **265**

Fresh citrus flavours underpinned by white peach and red fruit, with a balanced acidity.

Rosé Wines

Mostly made from red varietal grapes but using white wine-making techniques. Skin contact adds colour and intensity, and these wines can range from off dry to dry.

250ml | 750ml

Spier – Coastal **72 | 180**

This salmon-coloured Chardonnay & Pinot Noir blend is elegant, unpretentious and beautifully balanced, marrying strawberry and apple flavours with a crisp finish.

Nederburg Carignan / Grenache – Western Cape **78 | 220**

An abundance of vivid berry fruit – cherries, plum, blueberry, raspberry and strawberry – but then a dry, chalky grip reminiscent of freshly-squeezed pomegranate adds impact.

De Grendel – Durbanville **225**

On the palate, juicy notes of strawberry and raspberry are lifted by crisp acidity and a touch of mineral finesse, creating a wine that is both lively and elegantly structured. Light in texture but expressive in flavour, it lingers with a refined, clean finish that captures finesse and poise.

Buitenverwachting – Constantia **230**

This blend offers a combination of fresh strawberry and other red berries, giving it a refreshing crisp fruity finish.



Red Wines

Pinotage

South Africa's unique signature varietal. Created in 1925 by Professor Perold (1st professor of viticulture at Stellenbosch University) by crossing Pinot Noir and Cinsault. Currently enjoying an upsurge in popularity. It produces deep red wines with fruity, smoky, bramble and earthy flavours.

Van Loveren African Java – Robertson

79 | 208

Oak matured with vibrant plum and ripe berry fruit on the palate and an intense aroma of roasted coffee beans.

Warwick 1st Lady – Stellenbosch

290

A vibrant nose of rose petals, fresh currants, strawberries and ripe plums. The palate is light with finely textured tannins.

Beyerskloof Reserve – Stellenbosch

450

From mature bush vines, this wine spent 15 months in mostly 2nd fill French oak to deliver blackberry aromas upfront, mingling with sweet spicy oakiness. Juicy fruit follows the palate, with excellent balance.

Diemersdal Reserve – Durbanville

490

14 months in French Oak barrels. Full bodied and well-balanced with dark berry and plum flavours.

Kanonkop – Stellenbosch

1050

Truly iconic. Plush plum and cherry flavours with an evocative hint of spice. Forest-floor character and a delectable cassis-like, fruity core.



Merlot

Most widely planted cultivar in Bordeaux and is estimated to be the 3rd most grown varietal worldwide. Locally, it is the 3rd most widely planted red grape varietal.

250ml | 750ml

Van Loveren – Robertson

79 | 208

A lightly oaked and easy-drinking wine. Soft strawberry notes on the nose, followed by a rich, fruity palate, and soft tannins.

KWV Classic– Coastal

225

Generous and vibrant, this wine shows prominent aromas of ripe plum, raspberry and sour cherry with nuances of mint and cedary oak. The palate is accessible with indulgent tannins and a seamless finish.

Durbanville Hills – Durbanville

230

Spicy nutmeg and sweet dark chocolate aromas with prominent dark cherry and rich plum characteristics. Medium-bodied and well-rounded with soft tannins and subtle hints of raspberries lingering on the palate.

Steenberg – Constantia

450

The nose offers cedarwood and lavender, while the broody and deep palate reveals raspberry preserve, umami and spicy clove. The velvety texture is enhanced by a refreshing acidity, while well-integrated, fine tannins add structure.

Malbec

In South Africa, it has been grown since 1920. As a true steak pairing wine, it is steadily gaining popularity with our steak-loving nation.

250ml | 750ml

Rustenberg – Stellenbosch

118 | 335

Purple hues with dark fruit flavours such as plum, blackberry and violets, along with pepper and tobacco.

Diemersdal – Durbanville

360

Shows layers of ripe black fruit and spicy undertones up front. Aged in French oak barrels, a complex and concentrated wine with good structure, a mineral core and a velvety finish.



Cabernet Sauvignon

The most widely planted red wine grape, known as the King of Red grapes. In South Africa, it is used in producing single varietal wines, as well as blended with other Bordeaux varieties.

250ml | 750ml

Nederburg Winemasters – Western Cape

96 | 265

This ruby red complex wine shows delicious red fruit and blackcurrant, with a hint of spice and well-integrated oak. Lingering flavours with velvety tannins and a lingering aftertaste.

Warwick The First Lady – Stellenbosch

298

The palate is pure and fresh with classic notes of dark berries, rosemary, cigar box and dark chocolate. Tannins are finely structured and supported by a rich and creamy texture.

La Motte – Franschhoek

360

Elegant minerality and typical varietal characteristics such as berry and plum flavours and hints of cloves, mint and cigar box. Well-considered barrel maturation and firm but accessible tannins ensure a full-bodied wine with a rich consistency and lingering finish.

Springfield Whole Berry – Robertson

400

Whole berry maceration is followed by fermentation with natural yeasts, racking and one year's maturation in oak barrels. The result is a velvety wine with softer tannins and classical varietal characteristics.

Rust en Vrede Estate – Stellenbosch

790

A complex nose of blackcurrant, dark chocolate, tobacco, cedar, nutmeg, and pencil shavings. Refined and elegantly balanced on the palate where intense blackcurrant, black cherry, fresh plum, and mulberry combine with spicy and savoury note. The nose is opulent and ripe, offering intense aromas of brambles and classic cassis. The abundant red and blackberry fruit of the nose follows through with spicy notes of cinnamon with hints of espresso.



Shiraz / Syrah

Syrah continues to be the main grape of the northern Rhône, the 7th most planted worldwide and makes up 10% of vineyards in South Africa. Generally gutsy in flavour.
250ml | 750ml

Spier Signature – Western Cape **80 | 220**

Aromas of mulberry, cassis and blackberry are supported by subtle pepper and anise, balanced with smooth, dense tannins.

Saronsberg Provenance – Tulbagh **110 | 305**

Bold, fruit-forward New World characteristics. Typical white pepper is present, complemented with slight vanilla aromas coming from the barrels.

Hermanuspietersfontein Skoonma – Hemel & Aarde **500**

A Matured for 24 months in large French oak Foudres. Enjoy fresh aromas of red and purple fruits, notably mulberries, alongside savoury hints of fynbos and sweet spices like rosemary, thyme, and cinnamon.

Rust en Vrede Estate – Stellenbosch **790**

Expressive nose of creamy cherry puree and blackberries with a floral perfume of violet, spicy ginger and cloves. Fine, elegant tannins with a savoury grip are balanced by fresh acidity. Concentrated black fruit on the palate, with bramble, blackberry, mulberry and a hint of black pepper.

Porseleinberg – Swartland **1200**

Bold and expressive, exceptional quality and character. Perfectly sculpted tannic structure, and layers of dark fruit. An absolute masterpiece.

Pinot Noir

Cultivated in Burgundy, France, since the 1st century, this cultivar is grown worldwide, mostly in cooler climates.

Paul Cluver The Village – Elgin **310**

Raspberries, mulberries & ripe strawberries captivate your senses, while rose petals make a subtle appearance.

Creation – Cape South Coast **495**

A bevy of seductive red berries and the earthiness of shiitake mushrooms. Sheer romance in a glass. Hand-harvested, matured for 10 months in 10% new French oak and the rest second and third fill.



Red Blends

250ml | 750ml

Nederburg Baronne – Western Cape 82 | 215

A quintessential steak wine, this medium-bodied, smooth dry blend of Cabernet Sauvignon and Shiraz, shows delectable fruit and maturation flavours.

La Motte Millennium – Franschhoek 98 | 285

This Bordeaux style blend delivers dominant aromatic blackberries and plums, with nuances of fruit cake and dark toffee providing subtle sweetness.

KWV Roodeberg – Western Cape 98 | 285

This famous red blend shows aromatic layers of fresh red fruit, cassis and dark fruit with an undertone of sweet spices and dark chocolate.

Alto Rouge – Stellenbosch 305

Cedar and pine needles dominate the nose with a touch of freshly crushed berries.

Nederburg Double Barrel Reserve – Western Cape 315

Bright black cherry vibrance and succulence, toned by oak spice. Approachable but well-defined structure with integrated soft tannins and a lovely length.

Orpheus and The Raven Eternal Eight – Western Cape 400

A seamless blend of Bordeaux varietals, this wine celebrates the notion that despite our vices and virtues, that which unites us is greater than that which divides us. Dark fruit with a hint of spice, finishing in a juicy and luscious aftertaste

Spier Creative Block 5 – Stellenbosch 498

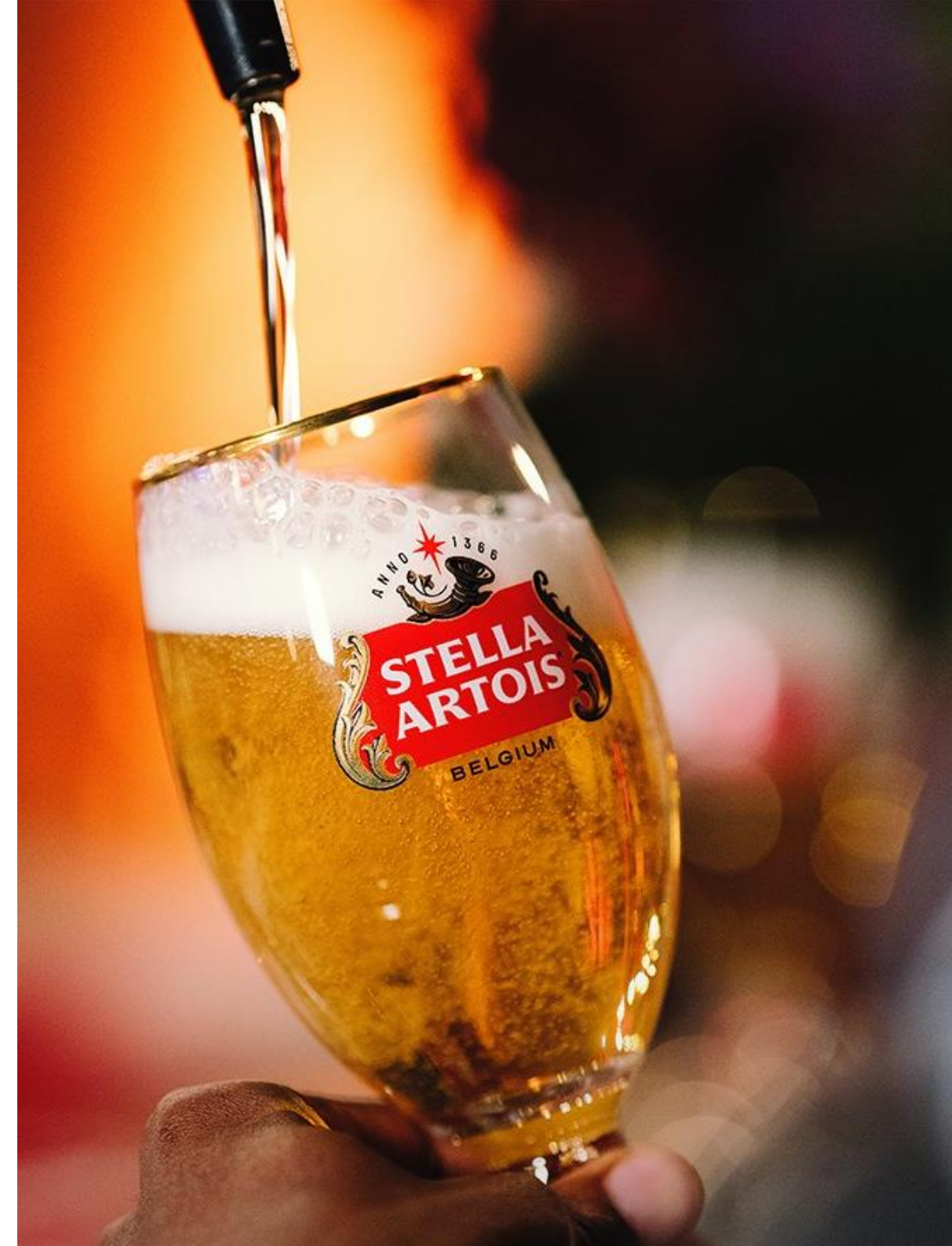
Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Cabernet Franc, Petit Verdot & Malbec. Blackberry and blackcurrant supported by cedar, dark chocolate and hints of fennel. The vibrant palate has good balance and dense tannins.

Rupert & Rothschild Classique – Franschhoek 520

This Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon and Cabernet Franc blend is matured for 16 months in French oak. On the nose it delivers nuances of fresh cranberry and wild black cherry, followed by a lingering voluptuous mouthfeel and silky-smooth tannins.

Meerlust Rubicon – Stellenbosch 990

Quintessential Rubicon nose with violets, ripe plum, cedar wood, fennel and intense spiciness. Typical liquorice notes are also evident on the nose. The palate is full bodied, structured and packed with fresh dark fruit.
